

We are excited you are interested in joining us for a LIVE Virtual Field Trip to a Dairy Farm! Please use the information below to help answer some of your questions.

Guidelines

- - You will be connecting to the virtual trips using Zoom video conferencing technology. You do not need a Zoom account to participate but will be prompted to download the Zoom plugin. To ensure your technology will work for the trip, we will provide pre-tour test links and tutorials, as well as opportunities to connect for practice sessions if extra assistance is required.
- - We highly recommend you have a way to present the trip on a large screen/surface and have speakers to plug into your computer to ensure the entire class can see and hear the farmer and others during the trips.
- - Due to the high volume of participants in our tours, we mute all classrooms' microphones and webcams. However, the chat window will remain open. Feel free to submit your questions and comments any time during your trip.
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- - We do ask teachers with classrooms participating in the trips to complete a pre and post tour evaluation form, which will be provided to you via email. We do this to ensure we are providing our participants with the highest quality experience. Your feedback is greatly appreciated!
- - If you find you are not able to participate in a scheduled trip, you may request to receive a recording of a trip during registration. Links to access these recordings are typically provided within a few business days after the conclusion of the scheduled trip.
- - The tour times (30 or 45 minutes) are concrete, we will end at the precise time listed and all tour stops will be made in this time frame. However, if there are more questions, we offer additional time at the end for classrooms that can stay.
